

Remembrance Assignment



- You will choose the format to complete the assignment (poster, poem, or essay).
- The focus is on Remembrance with an emphasis on Canadian content.
- A thoughtful, mature viewpoint will best meet the requirements. Graphic gore or violence will lower the quality of the work.

Poster: Colour or black and white (not a combination of both).

- Must be on poster paper, must have a 2 inch (5cm) border, all around the poster.
- Focus is on Remembrance with an emphasis on Canadian content.
- Must be all hand done, no computer use, magazines, etc.
- Name (first and last) must appear on the front of the poster, not in the border area.

Poem: Minimum of 24 lines, maximum of 32 lines.

- Should be rhyming and not free verse.
- Focus is on Remembrance with an emphasis on Canadian content.
- All original work, no copying from any source.
- Must be typed, with a title page, title at the top of the poem, name (first and last) at the top of the poem.

Essay/Story: Minimum of 600 words, maximum of 800 words.

- Should be more like a story of Remembrance than a factual description.
- Focus is on Remembrance with an emphasis on Canadian content.
- All original work, no copying from any source.
- Must be typed, with a title page, title at the top of the essay, name (first and last) at the top of the essay/story.
