48. <u>COL. R. M. LENDRUM BURSARY</u> \$1500

CRITERIA

- The Bursary shall be awarded to three (3) students in the district who intend to pursue a career in the field of education. This does not preclude students who wish to take undergraduate training in a faculty other than education prior to obtaining the necessary teaching training
- A Scholastic standing of not less than a C+ average is required
- Awarded annually unless, at the discretion of the committee, there is no eligible applicant
- The application is to include the financial circumstances of the student and his/her family
- The award shall be paid to the registrar of any accredited post-secondary institution upon written confirmation of acceptance received by the committee from the recipient of the award
- In the event that the recipient does not continue his/her studies during the year, any sum remaining from fees shall be returned to the CVTU
- Normally, the award will be paid out in the year following graduation. In certain circumstances, and with a written request to the CVTU, an extension may be granted
- Children or grandchildren of CVTU members or retired members will be given preferred consideration in the determination of the recipients of the CVTU bursaries
