

14. COWICHAN VALLEY DIVISION OF FAMILY PRACTICE SCHOLARSHIP

(also responsible for the Cowichan Valley Division of Family Practice Bursary)

APPLICATION DEADLINE APRIL 5, 2025

The purpose of this scholarship is to assist students in the attainment of higher education, where the student's intent is applying for a medical degree. The CVDFP scholarship is open to graduating students and citizens of the Cowichan Valley Regional District, School District #79.

CRITERIA

- Students proceeding to a training facility or enrolling in a program that would lead to a medical degree
- Students involved in extracurricular activities, school/community participation
- Students of high academic standing with average academic scores of at least 85%

CONDITIONS

- The Scholarship must be claimed within two (2) years of graduation and payable upon proof of enrollment
- The selection committee will be a physician member of the CVDFP
- Disbursement of funds will be by the Cowichan Valley Division of Family Practice

PROCEDURE

- Application form, stating graduating month/year
- Transcript of marks
- Autobiography essay, outlining academic plan, goals, and school activities that the student has participated in, or official positions held in these activities
- Two (2) letters of reference
- Resume
